

Ph.D. ADMISSION TEST-PROCEDURE AND SCHEDULE – 2020

A. Eligibility Criteria Minimum Qualifications:

- (i) M.Tech Degree of a University or equivalent for Ph.D. in Engineering / Technology in respective branch with 60% Aggregate Marks or CGPA not less than 6 on scale of 10.
- (ii) Master's Degree of a University for Ph.D. in Sciences / Humanities / Social Sciences / Management in respective discipline or equivalent with 60% Aggregate marks or CGPA not less than 6 on scale of 10.
- (iii) Consistently good academic performance is desirable.

B. Admission Procedure:

Admission shall be based on written test followed by personal interview of the shortlisted candidates only.

NET/SLET/UGC/CSIR(JRF) or equivalent national level examination qualified candidates are exempted from the written test.

Each eligible candidate will have to give a short presentation before the interview committee in the area of research interest.

D. How to Apply (*Opt for any of the following*)

- (i) Apply on line at www.getadmissions.com
- (ii) Download the application form from the web site www.juit.ac.in and send it to address given above. Application must be sent along with a **Demand Draft of Rs. 1,200/-** in favour of Jaypee University of Information Technology payable at Wagnaghat.
- (iii) You may also obtain the application from the office of Registrar, Jaypee University of Information Technology, Wagnaghat as per the above address by sending a draft of Rs. 1,200/- or purchase on counter with cash.

E. Written Examination Procedure

- (i) Tests / Questions shall be different for each discipline of the program.
- (ii) **Duration** : 120 Minutes (*60 minutes + 60 minutes*)
- (iii) **Full Marks** : 100
- (iv) Test will cover all the core / compulsory subjects in the relevant Master Level degree. Written test would aim at judging the depth of knowledge and potential to do research work.
- (v) The syllabi for each program have been loaded on the web site.

F. Personal Interview shall be conducted only for shortlisted candidates.

2. Format of Ph.D. Admission Test Question Paper (For Humanities and Social Sciences)

Distribution of Marks and Duration of Test

Part A:

(50%) 50 MCQs of 1 marks each in area of Research Methodology in Social Sciences, Qualitative and Quantitative Techniques.

Duration:60 Minutes

Part B :

(50%) 5 Descriptive Questions of 10 marks each (Only one area to be attempted out of 4 listed i.e. English Literature, Economics & Finance, Marketing, Human Resource).

Duration:60 Minutes

- H. **Institutional Fee:** The fee shall be Rs. 25,000/- per semester.
- I. Limited shared hostel accommodation is available for Ph.D. Scholars at an additional hostel fee of Rs. 63,000/- per semester which includes boarding and lodging.
