IMPORTANT ACADEMIC ANNOUNCEMENT

- Due to COVID 19, academic activities were suddenly interrupted and the students left for their homes as JUIT closed w.e.f 16 March 2020. Since then the Govt. announced National Lockdown w.e.f 25 March and the same has been extended thrice upto 31 May 2020.
- 2. To ensure the continuity of studies for the students, JUIT started online teaching w.e.f 29 March 2020, as per the guidelines of the UGC, AICTE, and Central/ State Govts. The online teaching is expected to be completed in the last week of May-2020. About 70% students are getting connected in this online mode. Balance, about 30% students have not been able to connect online due to various reasons, like internet connectivity issue, infrastructure related issues etc.
- 3. Before the students left, studies of half semester were practically completed in all the campuses and Test-1 was also conducted.
- 4. B Tech Final Year students who have attended classes online mode (OLM) are to give the via Google Form (secured approved platform by JUIT) Option of their willingness to appear in end term examination in online mode (OLM). On line examination will be conducted only for those students who will opt for it. This will enable them to join their respective employer.
- Others who could not attend the online classes, or do not want to appear in online examination due to some other reason, will be called ON CAMPUS MODE (OCM). As and when the University reopens these students will be provided remedial classes. Thereafter, their examinations will be conducted.
- 6. Following is the tentative schedule in line with the guidelines of UGC, AICTE, and Govt. to complete the studies of current semester (2019-20).

.All the classes will be divided in the following two groups:

Group A – B.Tech 1st year and 4th year

Balance academic activities (like remedial classes, laboratory classes and examination) from the point it got stopped of the students of Group A will be conducted and completed from 1st to 13th Jul 2020.

Group B – B.Tech 2nd year, 3rdyear, and other UG and PG classes

Balance academic activities viz. remedial classes, laboratory classes and examination of the students of Group B will be conducted and completed from 16th to 30th Jul 2020. They will arrive only by 15 Jul 2020..

- 8. All students on arrival at JUIT campus must be in possession of adequate face masks and personal sanitizer bottle for hostel room and shoulder bag. Entry of outside vehicles including taxis is not permitted beyond the Main Gate. Sanitization of luggage, student, Aarogya Setu App downloaded on mobile and proper documentation at Main Gate is a must before entry inside the campus.
- 9. Students must arrive in the campus only on the date specified above as all arrangements to include sanitization of hostels, opening of mess for food etc will only commence from that date. Entry inside campus earlier shall not be allowed.
