

CHANGES IN ACADEMIC SYSTEM EFFECTIVE EVEN SEMESTER 2010

A. Academic Progression: Fail/ Termination Of Registration Due To Not Meeting The Laid Down Criteria

(I) Following Conditions governing Failing of students or terminating the Registration are hereby cancelled

- (a) A student must have a CGPA of at least 4.5 and must not fail in more than 3 subjects (theory only) in a year to be declared promoted to the next class.
- (b) Further, the registration of a student of B.Tech. shall also be terminated and he/she may be asked to leave the programme if he/she fails to earn minimum number of credits in an academic year as stipulated in the Table.

(II) Revised Policy On Academic Progression is as under

- (a) All students will be allowed continued progression upto maximum duration as specified in ordinance for respective programme irrespective of the CGPA or earned credits or the failures in subjects, accrued by the students during the course of academic year and program. Maximum duration permitted for completion of B.Tech program is six years.
- (b) The student must first register for all backlog courses of the corresponding semester followed by the normal semester courses upto the maximum number of credits specified for that semester.
- (c) No relaxation in credit limit beyond 31 credits will be allowed. Further, such cases will be closely examined before approval by the VCs/Director, taking into consideration past performance of the students.

B. Examination/Evaluation System

(I) Make Up Examinations

The revised policy for allowing make up for approved genuine case only is as under

- (a) There will be no separate make up test for those who miss T1 or T2 due to approved genuine reasons.
- (b) Instead, the student's performance shall be evaluated at the end of the semester based on the balance two written papers (Teacher's assessment marks not to be taken into account) and pro-rata marks shall be awarded in either of the test T-1 or T-2, as missed by the student.
- (c) It is mandatory for a student to appear in T-3 test to be eligible for award of the Grade. Should a student miss the said exam for the genuine reasons, he / she shall be assigned an alternate makeup examination within a period of 10-15 days of the last paper of T-3 examination or as academically feasible to do so, as early as possible.

- (d) In case a student misses the make-up T-3 examination also due to continued genuine reasons, he/she will be required to take the supplementary examination which shall then replace the value of T-3 and the grades shall be computed accordingly. In such cases the students shall not be entitled to any additional benefit of supplementary examination.
- (e) Genuineness of missing the examination shall be determined and approved by VC / Director based on evidence submitted by student and opinion of University Medical Officers, in medical cases.
- (f) A student must apply for the make up test before last test / last date of the examination i.e. T-1, T-2 or T3. Post facto approvals shall not be accorded

(II) Supplementary Examination

- (a) The supplementary exams shall continue to be held as hither-to-fore for the commiserating semesters. The preparatory / coaching classes of 15 days prior to supplementary examination may be held at the discretion of the University.
- (b) Any student who has been awarded F grade because of being debarred due to attendance shortage shall not be allowed to take the supplementary examination. The student shall have to register for the course in the regular semester.
- (c) The examination shall be of 2 hours duration with complete syllabi.
- (d) The maximum grade awarded for the supplementary exam shall be up to C+ (four grades comprising F, D, C and C+).

(III) Overall Evaluation Systems

Henceforth allotment of marks, duration of each Examination and coverage of Syllabi will be as under:-
