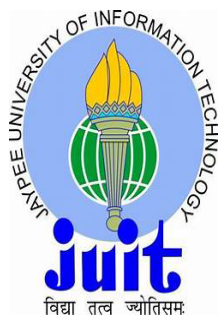


Gender Champions Club - JUIT
