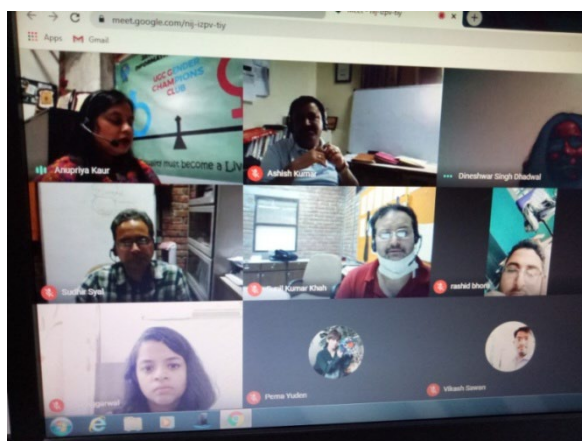


EVENT REPORT
