## Detailed Report on the Celebration of the 5<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of NEP 2020 – 29<sup>th</sup> July 2025

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### Background and Objective

The presence of a distinguished academic persona such as Prof. Sunil Kumar Khah, Prof. Rakesh K Bajaj offered the faculty and students an opportunity to engage in meaningful discussions on UGC initiatives, Grants and accreditation, Indian Knowledge System etc.

To commemorate the **5<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020**, Jaypee University of Information Technology (JUIT), Wagnaghat, organized a seminar on 29<sup>th</sup> July 2025. The highlight of the celebration was the lecture series and discussion among the students. ### Overview of NEP 2020

- Emphasized NEP 2020 as a transformative framework aimed at making Indian education more **holistic, flexible, multidisciplinary, and aligned to 21st-century needs**.
- Discussed the policy's vision of **equitable and inclusive education**.

### Key Provisions in Higher Education

- Implementation of **Academic Bank of Credits (ABC)**.
- Adoption of **flexible curriculum structures** and multiple entry–exit options.
- Promotion of **multidisciplinary learning** with emphasis on research and innovation.

- Shift from rote learning to **critical thinking, creativity, and experiential learning.**

#### **Quality and Accreditation**

- NEP stresses **outcome-based education (OBE)** and continuous quality improvement.
- Importance of **accreditation frameworks** (NAAC, NBA) and alignment of institutional practices with NEP objectives.
- Role of IQAC in monitoring, evaluating, and sustaining quality.

#### **Teacher Development and Student-Centric Learning**

- Faculty upskilling, capacity building, and pedagogical innovations.
- Use of **technology-enabled learning** (online, blended, AI-based learning platforms).
- Empowering students with skills for entrepreneurship, research, and global employability.

#### **Institutional Roadmap for JUIT**

- Prof. Khah highlighted steps for JUIT to align with NEP 2020, including **curriculum revision, credit transfer systems, interdisciplinary projects, research initiatives, and emphasis on innovation & incubation activities.**

Next, Professor Rakesh Kumar Bajaj, HoD (Maths) & NEP Coordinator, Wagnaghat discussed about Indian Knowledge System with the students on various aspects.







- Overview of Indian Knowledge System (IKS)

- Explained IKS as the **integration of ancient wisdom, culture, and traditional practices** into modern education.
- Emphasized contributions in fields such as **mathematics, astronomy, medicine (Ayurveda), yoga, literature, philosophy, art, and architecture**.

- IKS in the Context of NEP 2020

- NEP 2020 calls for the **promotion of Indian languages, arts, and cultural heritage**.
- Importance of **embedding Indian Knowledge traditions** into curricula to nurture pride, values, and critical thinking among students.
- Encouraging **multidisciplinary research** that connects traditional knowledge with modern science and technology.

- Relevance to Students

- Showed how concepts like **Panini's grammar, Vedic mathematics, and yoga practices** remain relevant in modern computing, AI, wellness, and problem-solving approaches.
- Highlighted the **global recognition of Indian traditions** (e.g., Yoga, Ayurveda) and their scope for innovation and entrepreneurship.

- Implementation at JUIT

- Suggested inclusion of IKS-related courses/electives and project work in academic programs.



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- Encouraged students to explore **research opportunities** bridging traditional knowledge with **computer science, engineering, and management**.
- Motivated learners to adopt an **interdisciplinary outlook** while connecting India's cultural wealth with modern applications.
