Viksit Bharat Youth Parliament 2025 at District Level 18th & 20th March 2025

The second round of the Viksit Bharat Youth Parliament 2025, organized by the Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports of the Government of India, was a landmark event that took place at Jaypee University of Information Technology (JUIT), which was designated as the Nodal Center for the Shimla and Kinnaur districts. Their rigorous assessment culminated in the selection of ten highly promising candidates—among them Ananya Negi, Yogesh, Anirudh Thakur, and others—who demonstrated exceptional potential and a deep sense of civic responsibility.











These selected youth now qualify to advance to the next stage at the state level, where they will further debate and discuss the theme "75 Years of the Indian Constitution: A Journey of Rights, Duties, and Progress," along with the "11 Sankalp of Samvidhan Divas," emphasizing a pledge to uphold constitutional values.

youth in the democratic process and discussions on key national issues.



शिमला और किन्नौर जिलों के लिए विकसित भारत युवा संसद 2025 का दूसरा दौर जेपी सूचना प्रौद्योगिकी विश्वविद्यालय (जेयुआईटी) में संपन्न हुआ, जिसे क्षेत्र के लिए नोडल केंद्र के रूप में नामित किया गया था। भारत सरकार के युवा मामले और खेल मंत्रालय द्वारा आयोजित इस पहल का उद्देश्य युवाओं को लोकतांत्रिक प्रक्रिया में शामिल करना और महत्वपूण राष्ट्रीय मुद्दों पर चर्चा को सुविधाजनक बनाना है। इस



आयोजन का उद्देश्य चार चरणों वाली चयन प्रक्रिया के माध्यम से 18 से 25 वष की आयु के प्रतिभागियों को सशक्त बनाना था, जिसकी शुरुआत माई भारत पोर्टल पर एक मिनट के वीडियो सबमिशन से हुई। इसमें शिमला और किन्नौर के 150 उम्मीदवारों को जेयूआईटी में जिला स्तरीय कार्यक्रम में भाग लेने के लिए शॉट लिस्ट किया गया।
