

President's Message


Fellow JUITians,

Raspberry pi (RPi)

A 15 pound computer initially designed with the goal of teaching children programming-Raspberry pi (RPi) is the beginning of an era of cheap, accessible, programmable computers everywhere. It is a credit-card sized computer that plugs into your TV and a keyboard. It's a capable little PC which can be used for many of the things that your desktop PC does, like spreadsheets, word-processing and games. It also plays high-definition video. Its major attributes being-It will not run WINE (or Windows, or other x86 software); Python is its default language but it also supports Java or any other language which will compile for ARMv6; Debian is the default distribution; and in it, the OS is stored on the SD card. The Raspberry Pi board contains a processor and graphics chip, program memory (RAM) and various interfaces and connectors for external devices. Some of these devices are essential, others are optional. RPi operates in the same way as a standard PC, requiring a keyboard for command entry, a display unit and a power supply.




