Prof. (Dr.) Ram Prakash Sharma ji is the Ombudsman of the committee. An Ombudsperson plays a vital and important role in the redressal of grievances of students, the principal stakeholders of the Indian higher education system.

The Hon'ble Chairman, UGC, conducted a meeting with all the Ombudspersons of the Universities to discuss the implementation of the Regulations on 5 February 2024 (Monday) at 2.00 P.M. through an online meeting. The meeting was live-streamed on UGC social media platforms.

Sharma** has visited Jaypee University of Information Technology, Waknaghat campus on **8**th **February 2024** and met the **Hon'ble Vice Chancellor Prof. Rajinder Kumar Sharma** and the Chairman of the SGRC Committee, Prof. Rakesh K Bajaj. The outcomes/deliberations during the interaction have been outlined as follows:

- 1. During the discussion, it was commonly proposed that during the orientation process of newly admitted students, we should have one interactive session of students with the Ombudsman (Prof. R P Sharma) of the committee.
- 2. The contact details (Mobile No., Email Id and Whatsapp No etc.) of the Ombudsman should be readily available on the university website.
- 3. Prof. R. P. Sharma also visited the boys hostels and girls hostels along with the Chairman of the committee (Prof. Rakesh K Bajaj) and Chief Warden (Dr. Rahul Shrivastava) and interacted some students personally for getting the feedback.
- 4. Prof. R. P. Sharma also interacted with some of the security guards also where he came to know about the bio-metric logging of incoming-outgoing of students from the hostels.
- 5. A brief report on the functioning of the hostel students was sought by the Prof. R. P. Sharma which is attached with this as Annexure I.
- 6. Also, all the necessary documents are attached with this report for the ready reference.

Caretakers Inside the hostel

Hostel life is facilitated by dedicated in-house caretakers responsible for overseeing various aspects of hostel management, including room inventories and maintenance needs. These caretakers reside within the hostel premises, providing immediate assistance and addressing any concerns or issues that may arise among the residents. Regular inspections and maintenance routines are conducted by the caretakers to uphold the standards of cleanliness and functionality within the hostel environment. Their presence ensures prompt response to emergencies and contributes to the overall well-being and comfort of the hostel community, fostering a supportive and nurturing living environment for students.

Security & CCTV Surveillance

JUIT campus boasts comprehensive security measures, including CCTV surveillance and round-the-clock security personnel stationed across the premises. The girls' hostel specifically ensures additional safety by employing female security guards, fostering a secure environment tailored to the needs of its residents. Continuous monitoring through CCTV cameras enhances vigilance and deters potential security threats, maintaining a safe atmosphere conducive to learning and personal development. With security personnel stationed at various posts throughout the campus, students can focus on their academic pursuits and campus life with peace of mind, knowing that their safety is prioritized.

Out-pass Slips

At the time of academic and hostel registration in the beginning of the semester, twelve printed outpass slips are provided to each hostel student. These out-pass slips are to be utilized when a hosteller plans to visit outstation. Prior permission of parents and slip duly signed by your respective warden is a must while exiting from the main gate of university. In case, both wardens of a hostel are not available, you may approach the Dy. Chief Warden, then the Chief Warden and thereafter the Dean of Students in that order. In case, if you have exhausted the out-pass slips, then report to your respective warden well in time so that necessary steps to procure the printed out-pass slips from university division can be taken before your next outstation leave. If the slips have been lost, a nominal charge is levied for the issue of fresh slips.

Timings for Hostellers/Non-Hostellers

Hostellers go out of the campus for a walk, bringing some daily needed items, having some snacks etc. All students need to put in biometric once while going out and once while coming back. Being a remote area and hills, there is a specific In-time for safety reasons. During summer season the Intime at the gate is up to 8:00 pm and in winters the In-time is 7:30 pm. If a hosteller defaults on Intime, disciplinary action may be taken. All girl hostellers must be inside their hostel by 9.30 pm. Biometric punch of check in is recorded. An SMS will be sent to parents of defaulting students. Any absence from campus between above timings and 8:00 am in morning must invariably be on an outpass duly signed by warden/chief-warden. Non-hostellers are requested to be out of JUIT Campus by 7:00 pm (Monday to Friday) and up to 5:30 pm on Saturday without fail unless written permission granted by the Dean of Students for any specific purpose exists.

Extended Library Timings for Hostellers

The facility of utilizing the Library resources is an important aspect for the academic growth of students. As such the hosteler students can avail the facility till midnight on regular weekdays. On Saturday, it is open till 5 pm and on Sundays up to 1 pm.

Anti-Ragging Committee & Squad of University

- Ragging is strictly prohibited in JUIT. As per the Supreme Court order on the subject, all
 mandatory bodies and mechanisms are in place to ensure that there is no ragging on the
 campus.
- All students and their parents are required to submit a copy of the Online affidavit which they submit on the UGC website.
- Besides above the following bodies are constituted by the JUIT:
 - o An Anti-ragging committee headed by the Vice Chancellor of the University.
 - An Anti-ragging squad headed by the Dean Academics which is deployed in various locations of the campus.
 - o Disciplinary Committee headed by a Head of Department.
 - All the Wardens are active and vigilant. In case of any difficulty, report to any committee/Dean of Students/Chief-Warden/Dy. Chief Wardens/wardens directly and immediately.
