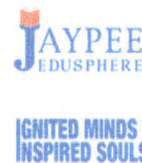

Agenda: 1 Welcome & Opening Remarks	The meeting was chaired by the Chairman of the Anti-Ragging Committee, Vice Chancellor Prof (Dr) Rajendra Kumar Sharma and attended by the members of the Anti-Ragging Committee, as notified vide Jaypee University of Information Technology, Wagnaghat Office Order No. JUIT/WKG/REGR/2026-27/044 dated 17 July 2026 (copy attached – Annexure-II). The Chairman welcomed all members of the Committee including Parent members of two students studying at JUIT, Wagnaghat – Mr. Rajiv Mishra and Mrs. Sarmistha Panigrahi (members of the Committee). A total of 26 Members (out of 30) attended the meeting (including five members through online mode). Four members of the Anti-Ragging Committee could not attend the meeting due to their prior engagements and were accordingly granted leave of absence by the Chairman of the Committee, as mentioned against each in the attendance sheet.	—
Agenda: 2 Review of UGC Anti Ragging Regulations	The Committee reiterated and affirmed that the provisions of the UGC Anti-Ragging Regulations, 2009, and the advisories issued by UGC are being followed in Letter & Spirit by Jaypee University of Information Technology, Wagnaghat. It was noted that all UGC Anti-Ragging Guidelines are available on the JUIT website. The members reaffirmed their commitment to ensuring strict compliance with the statutory requirements and resolved that all prescribed anti-ragging measures shall continue to be implemented effectively. It has been decided to share the UGC Anti-Ragging guidelines of 2009 (UGC Regulations on Curbing the Menace of Ragging in Higher Educational Institution, 2009) with all the members (through e-mail) for their ready reference, perusal and dissemination.	- Registrar
Agenda: 3 Functioning of Anti-Ragging Mechanism	The Registrar of JUIT Wagnaghat briefed the members on the functions and responsibilities of the Anti-Ragging Committee. The Committee also reviewed the constitution and functioning of the Anti-Ragging Committee, Anti-Ragging Squads, and Hostel Committees already notified in the University for effective coordination and implementation of anti-ragging measures.	- Registrar - Dean (Academics)
Agenda: 4 Preventive and Awareness Measures	The Committee reviewed the awareness initiatives undertaken for newly admitted students, including the Induction and Orientation programme and the Anti-Ragging Pledge administered by the Heads of	- Respective HoDs 



	Departments on the conclusion of the Induction programme sessions. It was also noted that Anti-Ragging notices, flyers and banners have been prominently displayed in the hostels as well as at various prominent locations across the University campus to create awareness among students.	- Dean of Students
Agenda: 5 Campus and Hostel Safety	The Registrar of JUIT Wagnaghat informed the members that CCTV surveillance systems have been installed across the University campus including prominent places around the hostels to ensure continuous monitoring and enhanced safety. Chairman informed the members that JUIT retains CCTV coverage footage for approx. 30 days, especially in respect of most frequent and prominent places within the Campus. Chairman advised that SOP in respect of CCTV Management may be reviewed. He further apprised the Committee that the Disciplinary Committees are conducting regular inspections to maintain discipline and support the effective implementation of anti-ragging measures.	—
Agenda: 6 Student Support and Counselling	The Committee reviewed the student support and counselling mechanisms available in the University. It was noted that various mental health policies, committees and awareness programmes are in place to promote students' well-being. The Committee further noted that the YourDOST , an online platform, is available 24×7 to the students to provide professional counselling services to them. Additionally, the Anti-Ragging Helpline number of the University has been prominently displayed at various locations across the campus and hostels to enable students to seek assistance in the hour of the need at any time. Chairman informed the members that JUIT follows the "Buddy System" where-in all the students have one another student as their "Buddy", so that in case of any emergent situation they can share & care authorized. The Chief Warden further brought out that JUIT has also notified Floor Leaders in each Hostel. Chairman directed the Dean of Students to ensure notification of the above aspects through the office of Registrar. Also, floor-wise WhatsApp Groups may also be created to under the supervision of respective Wardens/Resident Wardens.	- Dean of Students
Agenda: 7 Review of Complaints and Disciplinary Action	The Committee noted with satisfaction that no incident of ragging has been reported. It was further resolved that if any complaint received in future, it shall be examined promptly through due inquiry proceedings, in accordance with the UGC Anti-Ragging Regulations and University rules; and strict disciplinary action shall be taken against the individuals found guilty.	—
Agenda: 8 Anti-Ragging Action Plan	The Committee deliberated upon the Anti-Ragging Action Plan for the Academic Year 2026–27 and approved the following action points for effective implementation: (a) The Anti-Ragging Squads and Anti-Ragging Cell shall continue to perform their assigned duties on regular basis to ensure the effective implementation and monitoring of anti-ragging measures across the University Regular reports shall be forwarded to the office of Registrar.	- Dean (Academics)



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	(b) Registrar brought out that all requisite instructions/information/contacts for ready reference, are available on University Website and also displayed in Notice Boards across the University. It has been decided that large-sized Anti-Ragging flyers and banners shall be displayed at prominent locations, including the Open Cafeteria and near Basketball Court (BBC), to enhance awareness among students. (c) A dedicated WhatsApp Group shall be created by the Dean (Academics) to facilitate timely communication, reporting, and follow-up on any Anti-Ragging-related matters. (d) It was decided that 50 No-Ragging T-shirts shall be procured for use during Anti-Ragging awareness campaigns, orientation programmes, and other University activities to promote visibility and reinforce the message of a ragging-free campus.	- Registrar - Dean (Academics) - Dean of Students
Agenda: 9 Any Other Item with the Permission of the Chair	With the permission of the Chair, the members discussed various suggestions for further strengthening the Anti-Ragging mechanism and enhancing coordination among the academic departments, hostels, security personnel, and student representatives. The Chairperson emphasized the need for continued vigilance, proactive monitoring, and prompt reporting of any untoward incidents, and issued appropriate directions for the effective implementation of the Anti-Ragging measures.	—

1. ARC will ensure compliance to UGC Regulations as well as provisions as per law currently in force concerning ragging.
2. ARC will monitor and oversee performance of Anti Ragging Squad/Anti Ragging Sub Committee in Prevention of Ragging in JUIT Waknaghat.
3. ARC will forward reports of ARC Minutes to Monitoring Cell of JUIT and shall keep itself abreast of the decisions of the district level Anti Ragging Committee headed by DM.
4. It shall take appropriate decision in regard to punishments or otherwise keeping in view the nature of gravity of incident of ragging established in recommendations of the Anti-Ragging Squad.
5. The ARC may award one or more of the following punishments:
 - (a) Suspension from attending classes and academic privileges.
 - (b) Withholding/Withdrawing Scholarship/fellowship and other benefits.
 - (c) Debarring from appearing in any test/examination or other evaluation process.
 - (d) Withholding results.

- (e) Debarring from representing the institution in any regional, national or international meet, tournament, youth festival, etc.
- (f) Suspension/expulsion from the hostel.
- (g) Cancellation of admission.
- (h) Rustication from the institution for period ranging from one to four semesters.
- (i) Expulsion from the institution and consequent debarring from admission to any other institution, for a specified period.

6. This office Order supersedes earlier Office Order No. JUIT/WKG/REGR/2025-26/0507 dated 10 Feb 2026 on the above subject.
