Introduction

The Annual Training Camp-200 (ATC-200) was held from 9th to 18th July 2025 at UH&F Nauni, providing a ten-day immersive training experience for cadets of Jaypee University of Information Technology, Wagnaghat. These camps are essential in building the foundation for NCC cadets appearing for BEE and CEE certificate examinations. They cultivate unity, discipline, and leadership among the cadets, offering real-life insights into military training and teamwork.

Day 1

The camp commenced with biometric registration of all the cadets of Jaypee University of Information Technology, following which cadets were organized into different companies. Accommodation was arranged in a designated hall of Sambhu Hostel for the duration of the camp. Later the day concluded with a roll call and company-level leadership was established. LCPL. Raghav Joshi was given the opportunity to lead Bravo Company. The day concluded with an evening roll call followed by the singing of the NCC song, instilling a sense of unity and discipline among the cadets.

Day 2

The day began with a Physical Training (PT) session followed by a Drill practice. Cadets were introduced to the .22 mm rifle through a familiarization session. Day 3

The morning routine included PT and Drill as usual. Cadets learned to assemble and dismantle the .22 mm rifle. Various informative lectures were delivered throughout the day. An engaging game session was organized in the evening, followed by a briefing about the upcoming competitions. The day concluded with an insightful lecture by Lt. Day 8
